# U17MC(NW) 2020 Saturday Events-15<sup>th</sup> February, 18<sup>th</sup> July, 12<sup>th</sup> September & 5<sup>th</sup> December. CLUBMANS PRODUCTION CAR AUTOTEST and AutoSOLO SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS.

1. The Under 17 Motor Club North West will organise a Clubmans Production Car Autotest and AutoSOLO on Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> February, 18<sup>th</sup> July, 12<sup>th</sup> September & 5<sup>th</sup> December 2020 at M65 Motorway Services, Junction 4, Blackburn. Food is available on site (with discounts to Marshals).

#### Note the February PCA will be all forwards - others may include reversing.

2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions the promoting club may issue for the event.

#### 3. Permits

Motorsport UK Clubmans Permit No. 116026 and 116027 have been issued for the event on Saturday 15th February 2020 Motorsport UK Clubmans Permit No. TBC and TBC have been issued for the event on Saturday 18th July 2020 Motorsport UK Clubmans Permit No. TBC and TBC have been issued for the event on Saturday 12th September 2020 Motorsport UK Clubmans Permit No. TBC and TBC have been issued for the event on Saturday 5th December 2020

#### 4. ELIGIBILITY

- The event is open by initial invitation to Accrington Motor Sport Club, Under 17 Motor Club-North West, Formula 1000 Rally Club, Boundless by CSMA Club and all registered ANWCC Championship contenders. Entry is also open to members of other Motorsport UK registered clubs to a total of 15 clubs, allocated on first come first served (Subject to D11.1). Priority will be given in order of receipt of fully paid entries. All competitors (and some passengers) must produce a valid Club membership card and RS Clubman Competition licence (as a minimum). This licence is free of charge and can be obtained from Motorsport UK. You may also register for the ANWCC and SD34 Championships. Anyone who is not a member of one of the above clubs may apply for membership of the Under 17 Motor Club (NW) on the day, giving membership until 31 December 2020.
- Entries may be accepted from drivers of 14 and over at the date of the event, without a RTA Licence, but they may only drive a touring car up to 2000cc (forced induction) AND the passenger must hold a full RTA licence and be a person experienced in Autotesting. (See also General Rules regarding cabriolet/Sports Cars.)
- All PCA and AutoSOLO drivers are required to carry passengers in all timed tests. The passenger must
  occupy the seat alongside the driver and wear a properly fastened and approved seat belt at all times
  during the test. No other passenger is allowed.

All drivers and passengers will marshal during the day.

#### 5. CHAMPIONSHIPS

The event will be a round of ANWCC and SD34MSG Championships.

#### 6. PROGRAMME

Scrutineering will open at 10:30am

Signing on opens at 10:30. Any competitor not signed on by 11:00 may be disqualified.

First test starts at 12:00 Approx. The event is scheduled to finish at approx. 16:00. The December event may be 15:30

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#### 7. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

All cars must comply with the Road Traffic Act and the relevant Motorsport UK Technical Regulations. Cars should be currently registered. Proof of tax, insurance and MOT certificate (or vehicle registration document for cars under 3 years old) must be available at scrutineering. All cars should be driven to the event – see note below regarding stage rally cars. All cars must compete on road legal tyres.

**PCA**-stage rally prepared cars need not be taxed, insured or driven to the event but must present a Motorsport UK logbook AND valid MOT certificate.

8. CLASSES

Class A = PCA Cars

Class B = AutoSOLO cars.

9. AWARDS - No Awards will be given. All entries will get one McDonald's/Costa Discount voucher for use in the day.

#### 10. ENTRY

The entry list opens on publication of these Supplementary Regulations and closes finally on the Sunday preceding the event date. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt. The entry fee per competitor is £35. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee.

A limited number of places are available in a Driving School car with an instructor for an addition fee of £70-this must be booked at least 14 days before the event.

Late entries may be available if the event is not full. Late entries may be accepted up to one hour before the event starts.

11. The maximum entry for the meeting including reserves is 16, the minimum is 1.

#### 14. MARKING AND PENALTIES.

• If a driver returns to the point of their mistake, and then completes the test correctly, a wrong test does not apply.

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#### 15. GENERAL RULES:

- PCA-Cabriolet/Sports Cars will compete with the hood erected or a hardtop fitted.
- For Saloon cars and cabriolet/Sports Cars competing with the hardtop fitted if the driver holds a valid, non-provisional RTA Licence the passenger must be 12 years or over, be at least 135cms in height and must have signed on.
- For Cabriolet/Sports Cars competing with or without the hood erected or a hardtop fitted if the driver holds a valid, non-provisional RTA Licence the passenger must be 16 or over, be at least 135cms in height and must have signed on (M16 & M21).
- Test diagrams will be provided to competitors at signing on. All competitors will have an opportunity to walk each test layout before timed runs start for that course.
- Each driver will have two or more runs at each layout. The number of predicted runs will be announced at the drivers briefing; runs are dependent on weather conditions and delays on the day.
- PCA the run with the slowest time, including penalties, will be discarded in calculating the results. **AutoSOLO all times count.**
- Competitors will start in their own time upon clearance from the timekeeper. Timing will start when the front wheels cross the timing line. Timing will stop when the front wheels cross the flying finish line. The car must stop astride the stop line if further penalty is not to be incurred.
- A Stop Signal will be displayed if there is an obstruction on the course. A competitor must stop immediately on deployment of the signal and a re-run allowed. The Stop signal will be displayed at the drivers briefing
- In the event of a tie the fastest run of the first course will determine the tie, and then the fastest on the second course, etc. until the tie is resolved. To be classified as a finisher, competitors must start at least one run at all courses or as per Motorsport UK General Regulations.
- The competitor will observe all instructions from the marshals or driving instructor.

#### 16. IDENTIFICATION:

Competitors will be identified by numbers provided by the organisers, which should be clearly displayed in the driver's side rear window or nearest equivalent.

#### 17. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The Motorsport UK General Regulations apply as written except for the following amendments:-

- M2 Judges of Fact: All officials, and competitors while acting as marshals, will be judges of fact for the purposes stated in M2.2
- M11.3 A vehicle may be entered twice or more, to be driven by different drivers.
- Table M.7 Timing will be by hand held stop watches to the previous tenth of a second. Penalties shall be as SR14 above.
- M6.6 Markers may be less than 1 metre in height.

#### 18. RESULTS:

Provisional results will be on display throughout the event and as soon as possible at the end of the event at which point any protest must be lodged in the correct manner, in accordance with C5, within 30 minutes. Otherwise results will become final and the awards presented.

Results will be sent out by e-mail as soon as possible after the event and placed on <a href="https://www.anwcc.co.uk">www.anwcc.co.uk</a> web site. If you wish to receive copies of results by post, please include a stamped addressed envelope with your entry.

All details of tests will be available at signing on. If you need assistance in finding the venue contact one of the Officials. Final instructions will be issued during the week leading up to the event.

- 20. USE OF MOBILE PHONES For the purposes of the safe running of the event the use of mobile phones by competitors in the test area is prohibited, whilst queuing before the start of a test or returning to the paddock area. Any competitor found to be in breach of this regulation may be disqualified from the event.
- 21. INSURANCE EXCESS In the event of a claim having to be made for damage caused to third party property by any Competitor, the Organisers of the event will pass on the insurance excess under the Motorsport UK Master Policies (currently £450 per incident) to the competitor(s) involved.
- 22. Data In accordance with latest General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) the information you give us will be used only for the purpose of running U17MC(NW) events and its activities. You will only receive communications from us that are relevant to the events you enter. Photographs may be taken at this event (and others in the programme) and shared, including on social media. Please advise the organiser if you do not wish to have your photograph taken.
